The authors discuss their uses within the curriculum; in projects such as oral history archives, publications such as the popular *Foxfire* books, and other media productions; and in researching current community problems. Useful appendixes survey a variety of reference tools for the oral historian and describe in detail how a *Foxfire*-concept magazine may be developed.
